- on-set puppet maintenance

- final checks of puppets before each shot

- creating background puppets using wire and silicone
- styling fur
- styling hair and wigs
- creating spare hands for each character
- trimming and seaming
- air brushing for silicone
- mixing silicone colours
- casting plastic eyes, glueing paper pupils onto eyes
- sanding and painting miniature 3D printed characters
- making replacement collars for puppet's shirts
- sculpting, molding and casting for dog tongue used in closeup
- creating "singed" look on dogs using coloured hairspray
- creating "wet" look on dogs using hair gel
- punching and laying fur on silicone puppets
- adding paw pads to dogs when needed for the shot
- opening rigging holes in silicone and fabric
- mending torn costumes
- airbrushing bruised foot
- redesigning old puppets into new background characters
- paint matching puppets during each movement stage for replacement animation
- repairs and paint blending of silicone puppets
- painting "growl" dentures for dogs
- cleaning stained costumes
- altering silicone puppets to allow exaggerated movements
